Topics for discussion at meetings over the next few months

1. JDF      Probable date, during last week in Feb, 21-25

Acrobat 7 includes a way to originate JDF files. How will this be used?

2. Server software and desktop

Acrobat 7 seems to include some desktop options that do not require server software. For example the commenting enabled in this PDF for Reader. Previously Reader Extensions was required. Also a form can send data as an email attachment. There is no need to send the data through a server.

Is this a way forward for those who find the Adobe server software expensive? What other options are there?

What examples exist in Europe of government sites where a PDF form exists and is supported by Reader Extensions? So far there seem to be none in the UK. Some good case studies could be identified before Seybold in June.

3. SVG Has there been any progress? Previous discussion around David Brailsford's presentation on data and design has tended to spend more time on SVG. The PDF slideshows seem to use SVG somehow.

4. Mac can create PDF. What use is being made of the new features?
